Good news. Below is an update from Peter Lawrence re the status of the introduction of 50 series tyres for early model cars to get around our current (and future) tyre shortage crisis.

Basically, a bulletin will be issued next week, but the rule won't become law at CAMS events until 1st of April which is before our first CAMS event this year.

For our first event this year at Winton run under AASA, I have spoken to the organisers and arranged a dispensation for 50 series tyres for that particular event. The scrutineers there will be working on the new rule.

re tyres, I can now say that 50 will be acceptable from 1 April for all cars, with 16" for 6 and 8 cylinder cars as per the IPRA request.

A Bulletin to this effect will be issued by early next week. The Commission have ratified it by the acceptance of the RWG Notes. The 6 speed gearbox and Rear wing change for Late Model have also been accepted. The extra rim width For late model is still under discussion so won't happen on 1 April.
