

2007 Victorian Points System:

What's the Point(s)

New year and a new points system, just like V8 Supercars! Seriously, with the change in race format we needed to revise our points system to avoid the previous situation of having messy decimal points. The committee have also decided that the points gap for winning should be increased (minimally) as more reward for being first past the post. All of these changes affect the Club (Outright) and Class championships. The new points are:

The system is loosely based on the points system used for the MotoGP bikes. Each round will be worth up to 120 points for a clean sweep of races, as before every finisher gets points. At this stage all CAMS VSCRS rounds will be 3-race weekends and all AASA events will be 4-race weekends, there are no plans for a 2-race weekend, however, the provision is there. If we ever end up having a 5-race weekend we will deal with it then!
