The joke



Past Tracks

Do you know there was once a race track through Mildura? Well, most people would not, as its been a while since some noise ran through the street circuit. The Mildura circuit was a motor racing venue which was used for largely motorcycle road racing events from 1954 to 1956. It was located next to Mildura Airport and ran along a section of the Sturt Highway.

At the time, the six-kilometre long circuit was the fastest in Australia with an average speed of around 160-kilometres per hour and a main straight exceeding 1.6-kilometres in length.

The first race on the new circuit was in 1954 however, even after substantial council funds had been invested in resealing sections of the circuit, its life was short lived with the final race being held on Boxing Day 1956.

To give members some idea of what is required to plan such an event, here are some key tasks:


Event Format – Number and length of races including under and over 2 litre, etc

Past Events

Bathurst

A number of eager members hit the highway for the annual 12 hour event at Bathurst in February with 14 Victorians out of 57 qualifiers hitting the track on Friday. Many of these were first timers to Bathurst, but they quickly wrapped there mind around the enigma people call the Mountain.

Unfortunately, some debate with officials over CAMS National Rules prevented some Vic members qualifying, who were banished to perform some last minute modifications.

Fastest in qualifying was Tasmanian Ray Hislop with a 2:24.75 followed my Matt Cherry in the Monaro from WA with a 2:28.7. Like last year, Leigh Forest highlighted the diversity in IP qualifying 3rd with a 2:29.2 in the bright Yellow Celica. Fastest of the Victorians was David Cocks who managed the stretch the Commodores legs setting up a 28th grid position. M3 BMWs then lead the way with Phillip Showers, John Angioella and Andrew Butcher all lapping within a second of each other. Victorian entrants not able to qualify included Nathan Robinson and Graeme McPherson. Tony Groves unfortunately experienced engine issues however quick work by his pit crew had

him mobile for Race 1.

It was not a great surprise to see the Falcon of Hislops take out the chequered flag and bring his fastest time down to a 2:21. New to the top 3 finishers was Michael Naguib who nudged out Leigh Forest in a Datsun 1600. The IPRA Vic team including Nathan Robinson finished 24th, in front of Cocks who was experiencing some handling issues with the VK. Angioella was 3rd in the Vic group finishing in position 27. Interestingly, of the Victorians, half of them lapped within 1 second of each other in Race 1.

Race 2 was where the action unfolded with Monaro of Cherry taking the chequered flag after Hislop had an incident at conrod chase leaving him in litter. Without contributing to it, Rolf Mamars was involved in the incident resulting in significant damage to the RX7 and we wish him all the best getting the car back on the track.

By the days end, 4 of the 14 DNF's were Victorian's with Cocks, Graeme McPhersons and Showers taking out the top 3 finishes with the Vic's in 16th, 21st and 23rd positions respectively.

As expected, response to expressions of interest for 2017 have been extraordinary, highlighting that the popularity of the event is getting stronger along with the strength of IP Nationally.

Round I - Phillip Island

Those who missed practice on Friday at Phillip Island on April 29 didn't miss much with most runs involving avoiding water, oil, fuel, mud, gravel and in some cases, all of it on the circuit in what was 'unpleasent' conditions. Fortunately things improved for Saturday with 44 entrants lining up to qualify in fine conditions. Fastest was South Australian Grant Maitland who lapped in 1:44.79 in the Nissan Silvia, with 2nd fastest going to Nathan Greier and 3rd to Robert Braune, both in the low 1:47's and driving BMW's.

Fine weather continued for Race 1 which saw the Silvia of Maitland's first see the chequered flag, followed by a convoy of BMWs driven by Braune, Greier and Nathan Robinson. Tony Groves continued to evolve as future force in the well prepared RX7, while Jason Fankhauser finished 6th after an electrical fault in qualifying parked the rebuilt Commodore at Luke Heights.

With 39 starters, Geier embraced a damp track to win Race 2, in front of an interesting battle between South Australia John Woodberry's Magna and Robinsons BMW.



Tony Groves made up a position finishing 4th, while Graeme McPherson continued to find his feet in the fastest V8 finishing a respectable 5th. After 6 failed to finish Race 1, it was pleasing to see a more reliable field than 2015 with 36 of 39 finishers crossing the finishing line.

Race 3 saw the return of the Maitland Nissan to number 1 after the weather presented a dry track, with Braune and Robinson BMW's finishing the top three. The Magna of Woodberry finished a successful weekend in 4th in front of Geier's BMW E36. After a Race 2 DNF due to a master cylinder jamming, Fankhauser weaved through the traffic from last to 8th, whilst Tony Groves lost a few positions after a brief detour on to the green stuff finishing 11th. McPherson, who experienced a blown tyre, managed a 9th place and an overall 7th outright.

360 degree cameras by Jason Fankhauser

Its wasn't too long ago people were strapping the wife's home video camera onto the role cage to get some footage to show people at home on the 68cm. The GoPro like camera launched into the market, and suddenly people were filming and uploading to Youtube footage in and outside the car. Integration of such footage into telemetry/analysis software is now as standard as a camera on a mobile phone.

But now, we have a new realm to race video with the launch of 360 degree cameras like 360fly (360fly.com). My engine builder asked me the other day why I don't use 360 vision in the cockpit and I thought he was on drugs. He then dragged his iphone out of his pocket, and showed me footage of a burnout at Summer nationals. Holding his phone out in front of us, he moved it around a circle, and the footage moved accordingly just like we were in the car. He could even raise it up and look at the sunshine. Much like virtual reality I guess.

Mounting it on the parcel shelf of a race car means you get 360 degree footage all in one camera. Although I had heard of such a thing, I had no idea the prices for this technology were down to the \$400+ mark.
